

# Public Celebration of Liturgy during **COVID-19**

**The obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains lifted until further notice, especially if you are part of a vulnerable population and/or have an underlying health condition.**

**If you have a fever and/or cough you should stay at home regardless of your travel or contact history.**

(No symptomatic or COVID-19 positive persons are allowed on site and anyone who has had contact with any other person who is diagnosed with COVID-19 are required to quarantine for 14 days.)

**Please approach the celebration of Mass with charity and love for our clergy and faith community by following these protocols:**

- Stay home if you are sick or not feeling well.
- Masks are required upon entry and during Mass.
- Sanitize your hands upon entry. Due to shortages of sanitizer, please bring your own if possible.
- Sit in designated pews and respect social distance between others of 6 feet or more (at least two chairs) unless you are one family unit. *\*Please begin seating in the middle of a pew to utilize space and avoid others having to pass one another in too close proximity.\**
- Refrain from congregating in tight areas or entering cordoned off areas.
- Follow protocols to receive Holy Communion as directed as Mass.
- Follow church protocols regarding registration due to the 25% capacity limit.

- Stay home if you are sick or not feeling well.
- Masks are required upon entry and during Mass.
- Sanitize your hands upon entry. Due to shortages of sanitizer, please bring your own if possible.
- Sit in a way to respect social distance between others of 6 feet or more unless you are one family unit. Two chairs is the equivalent of 6 feet. If sitting in the front row, do so in an area where no one is seated behind you.
- Only 10 people are allowed at daily Mass. (Each family member in a unit is counted towards the limit). Be conscious of the number of people in the Church and do not enter if there are 10.
- Refrain from congregating in tight areas or entering cordoned off areas.
- Remain in your seated area to receive Holy Communion; Father will bring it to you.
- Please note, only one bathroom will be open, and available for emergency use only.
