MASS SIGN-UP INFORMATION:

We may all be suffering a bit from “Covid Fatigue” as we head into the fall months, but it is more important than ever that we each do our part to stay safe and protect one another.

****PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE REQUIRING YOU TO SIGN UP IN ADVANCE TO ATTEND WEEKEND MASS HERE IN CHURCH.**

To register, you may either call the rectory at 893-2487, or go to the parish website at: www.stannmilton.com and use the link to the sign up page. ** Each person must INDIVIDUALLY sign up; do not sign up “Smith family”, rather it should be “Jim Smith, Sue Smith, John Smith, Jane Smith.”

Upon arrival at church, a greeter will check your name off of the attendance list. If you have come WITHOUT reserving a spot, you will have to wait before entering church to make sure our numbers are in compliance. If the 85 person limit is reached, you will not be able to stay for the Mass. We DO NOT wish to turn anyone away that wants to come and worship; we also do not wish to make any parishioner feel uncomfortable if there are too many people. Reminder that we can accommodate 85 people per Mass to maintain the social distance requirements.

CHRIST OUR HOPE: BUILDING A VIBRANT CHURCH: 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18: “Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.”

As of 11/6 the overall campaign has raised \$2.4 million in gifts and pledges of the \$10 million goal, approximately 25%. Here at St. Ann, we have reached 16% of our parish 3-year goal, with \$43,046 raised in gifts and pledges.

Next weekend (11/21 & 11/22) we will host a Virtual Weekend of Giving. We will recognize the success we've realized in a few short weeks and will encourage those who've yet to make a gift to do so.
