MASS SIGN-UP INFORMATION!

In-person Mass attendance has continued to rise—we are so glad to see so many of you! Reminder that we accommodate 85 people per Mass to maintain the social distance requirements.

****PLEASE NOTE: WE ARE REQUIRING YOU TO SIGN UP IN ADVANCE TO ATTEND WEEKEND MASS HERE IN CHURCH.**

There are two ways to reserve space for Mass: either call the rectory at 893-2487, or go to the parish website at: www.stannmilton.com and use the link to the sign up page.

➔ **** Remember that each person must INDIVIDUALLY sign up; do not sign up "Smith family", rather "Jim Smith, Sue Smith, John Smith, Jane Smith."**

Upon arrival at church, a greeter will check your name off of the attendance list. If you have come WITHOUT reserving a spot, you will have to wait before entering church to make sure our numbers are in compliance. If the 85 person limit is reached, you will not be able to stay for the Mass. We DO NOT wish to turn anyone away that wants to come and worship; we also do not wish to make any parishioner feel uncomfortable if there are too many people. This is a time we must respect one another; we are doing this to keep Fr. Feltz, Deacon Paul, and everyone in our St. Ann Parish family safe and healthy. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

MESSAGE FROM FR. FELTZ: I have received permission from Bishop Coyne to stay on as pastor of St. Ann's past my 75th birthday next June (until June of 2022). Ordinarily priests retire at age 75; but, if they are healthy and do not yet want to retire, they can ask permission of Bishop Coyne to stay on an additional year. As you all know, this year has been a very challenging one for the parish with the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic. I want to stay here with all of you to see the parish through this time.

PARKING LOT: Over the last several years (especially in winter) we have had issues with the deteriorating condition of our parking lot. We have received permission from the Diocese to make major repairs to it; ECI Construction will be doing the work and hope to begin work this month. We will be paying for the project from our parish funds, and hope to use some of the money we receive from the *Christ Our Hope* campaign to offset some of the expense as well.
